# **Gender Management Service**



Phoenix Children's Hospital is the only children's hospital in Arizona with a comprehensive Gender Management Program. We provide outpatient services geared towards supporting the physical, mental, and social health of children and youth and their families as they progress through their gender identity development. As specialists in pediatrics, adolescent medicine, and psychology, we recognize that the process of gender identity development is uniquely individual. Our providers determine the best treatment plan for each individual in collaboration with youth, families, physicians, mental health therapists, and other specialists that may be involved in their care.

Patients served by or clinic include:

- Gender non-conforming youth: Children and adolescents who exhibit behavior not typical of their assigned birth sex
- Gender questioning youth: Children and adolescents who are questioning their gender identities (e.g., "I was born a girl, but I wonder if I'm really a boy?")
- Transgender youth: Children and adolescents whose gender identity is different from their assigned birth sex (e.g. "I was born a girl, but I am really a boy,"
