Do your civic duty: <u>VOTE!</u> And here's how you can do it safely



YES, this is rather early to talk about, but in order to vote safely, and feel like we have at least <u>something</u> under our control, we need to prepare in advance. If life with this Corona-virus pandemic has taught us anything, it is to be prepared for the unexpected.

SO:

First of all, make sure you are registered to vote in Arizona.

Mark down these dates on your calendar. Then underline them, circle them and put alerts on your phone reminding you of them:

July 24 and Oct. 23.

Those are the dates by which you must request an early ballot if you don't already automatically get one. If you choose not to risk life and limb this year in order to exercise your constitutional right to vote.
